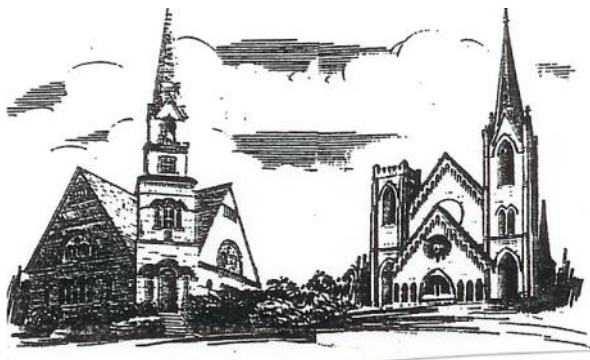
The Apostles’ Creed.....
