# **EKLC Council Meeting Minutes** November 16th, 2021

Meeting was called to order at 6:15 pm. Those in attendance were Kristen Lien, Oren Hammes, Kim Timler, Nathan Stach and Jason Schlieckau.

Ron Knapwurst added to agenda

Devotions-Kristen Psalm 23

Financial updates: Profit/Loss statement, Money Market account and Memorials. There were a couple memorials. One was designated to Senior Choir and was applied in Money Market. Holly has applied another to the cemetery. New window expense was taken out of Undesignated Memorials. Income up compared to this time last year. Question brought up by Judy regarding budgeting for next year. Last year we used a financial committee to prepare the budget. Likely will do the same this year, and will have the budget ready for December Council meeting. PPP loan payoff was placed in Misc income.

Motion to approve financials made by Oren, seconded by Jason, passed.

Review of Minutes from October meeting. One correction on wording. Youth Director search put on hold, instead of pastor search.

Motion to approve Minutes made by Oren, seconded by Kim, passed.

Submitted reports reviewed: Education and Worship.

Motion to approve reports made by Oren, seconded by Jason, passed.

Ron Knapwurst led discussion relating to changes in the Trust Committee. Trust Committee will spend the next month updating the set of rules and quidelines with technicalities to be clarified relating to fund usage and bylaws. Council then to vote on taking these modified bylaws to congregation.

#### **Old Business**

Thank you cards discussed.

Judy and Heidi anniversary celebration discussion. In 2020 Judy reached 60 years of service to our church. Heidi has reached 37 years of service and, coming out of retirement, has volunteered to help with the Christmas program again. Kim to reach out to Vicki to lead the honoring of Judy and Heidi with regard to their years of service. Targeting March timeframe.

Unsung hero nominee for the month is Erica Lien.

#### Covid update:

In person worship. Mask mandate is now through 11/27. This is supposed to be the last mandate. If mandate continues however, then church is still on status quo with regard to masks, coffee hour, Communion, etc. WELCA wants to do a Christmas tea during coffee hour on 12/5 assuming mask mandate is done, this is acceptable.

Communion at the rail discussion. What would this look like? Some churches have it while others don't. Table this topic until after Holiday and look at giving people options for Communion at the rail starting in January. This all happens if mask mandate goes away. Worship committee to come up with Communion guidelines and figure out logistics. If mask mandate does go away, we will still say masks are recommended but not required.

Call committee status: They've met with Marie from the synod a couple times. They've also done a mock interview with Holly from Liberty. Next steps coming. They have some names and interest from possible pastors.

Supply pastor status: Covered until at least the end of the year. Confirmation discussion with regard to fill-in pastor:

Motion was made by Oren to offer a contract to Eric Bakken of West Koshkonong to teach Confirmation classes starting the first Wednesday in January through the last Wednesday in May at East Koshkonong lasting an hour and fifteen minutes each Wednesday night from 6 PM to 7:15 PM. We will compensate him \$40 per hour or \$100 per week for time and prep. Pastor Eric to also be responsible for the Confirmation Sacrament in May. Motion seconded by Jason, and passed.

Kristen to contact Eric and work with Holly on contract.

Roof leak update:

Kristen to get update from Tom.

## **New Business**

Putting hymnals and Bibles back in pews discussion. Doing this after worship with the congregation seems like a great idea. Like how they used to "move Libraries" in the olden days. Target 12/12, the Sunday before Christmas program, for this to happen. Kim to ask Vicki to coordinate.

Ribbons/tape on pews. We will be removing this after meeting tonight.

Council is required to find an Audit committee member. We would be replacing Natasha Amundson this year. Council to give thought on who to nominate.

Church Mutual audit. Need by annual meeting. Council to think about and report next meeting.

Ideas for Nominating committee for council term starting next vear- discussion.

Newsletter discussion article on coffee hour.

Signup sheet in lower level friendship hall now but this will be moved to narthex.

### What you need:


- Small stones

# EKLC In-Person Worship Guidelines Updated 12/15/2021

The Public Health Madison & Dane County will continue to require all individuals aged two and older to wear a mask while in any indoor space open to the public. East Koshkonong will continue to follow and base our guidelines from Dane County directives as well as best practices from the CDC.

EKLC will continue to require individuals to be masked while inside our buildings. We recommend that any member or guest follow CDC guidelines related to mask wearing while on church property, but not outside our buildings. Worship:

- · We will continue to live stream services on Facebook and YouTube
- · Offering will be collected in baskets in the Narthex.
- · Communion will continue be held weekly and will be distributed upon entrance to the sanctuary.

Council approved having the worship committee provide an option for attendees to worship at the front of the church beginning 12/24/21. We would like an option for folks who are not comfortable doing so and wish to remain in their seats.

· The gathering and sending hymns will continue to be sung during worship.
