**Christmas:** Narthex tree may be artificial. Sanctuary and windows (circles put up, decorate tree in Sanctuary).

**Easter:** Lilies are preferred, ordered and paid for by members; delivered on Good Friday, arranged after Good Friday service. Check with church secretary: platform for altar display is stored in locked room in Narthex (secretary has key).

## Monthly Circle Duties



1. Serve monthly WELCA meeting.
2. Conduct business meeting.
3. Altar set up and take down for communion for the FIRST TWO Sundays of the month.
4. Provide flowers for the altar, change banners, and fill candles each Sunday of the month.
5. Select ushers for each Sunday of the month. Check sign up sheet in Narthex for possible volunteers.
6. Serve coffee hour on the 4th Sunday of your month.
7. Oversee appearance of the Ladies' Lounge.
8. Check and sharpen pencils in communion racks.
9. Refill offering envelopes (2 per space).
10. Replace scratch paper (2 per space).
11. Send \$15.00 to Jail Ministry by June.
12. Visit shut-ins and send cards and letters.
13. Keep in contact with the office for changes in services.
14. Occasionally, help serve receptions for weddings, anniversaries, funerals for deceased circle members and families.
15. Circle members who are unable to serve are asked to

## Duties of the Ushers

1. Greet people as they come in. Be early; some people come as early as 8:15 a.m. Smile – be friendly.
2. Wear usher badges (found in the cabinet in the Narthex).
3. Hand out bulletins/communion cards.
4. Seat late-comers.
5. Count the attendance. Do NOT count attendance during the offering as you may lose count. It is important that we have accurate count for our church attendance.

ATTENDANCE COUNT IS WRITTEN ON  
'RECORD SHEET' AND PUT ON TOP OF  
OFFERING PLATE.

6. During a Communion Service, two ushers stand in front to receive the registration cards and assist those who need help going up the steps. Two ushers usher out the communicants into the aisle, keeping the aisle full from both sides. About 9 or 10 persons are needed to fill each side of the communion rail.
7. Pick up any bulletins or other items left in the pews. Straighten hymnals.
8. Take complete communion cards to the church office after worship

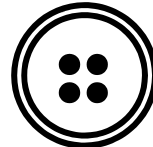
## SEWING KITS

**“I can sew!” are words which translate into a previously lacking income for newly trained tailors and seamstresses in villages and urban slums overseas. Their dedicated teachers showed them how to master a treadle sewing machine and how to make patterns for garments that reflect their own culture. Now the new sewers are able also to say, “I can take care of myself and those I love”.**



### **Each sewing kit is to contain the following:**

- **“Three yards of 44” wide three or four yards of 36” wide of cotton or cotton blend fabric.”**
- **One package of needles for hand sewing**
- **One spool of matching thread**
- **One card of buttons**



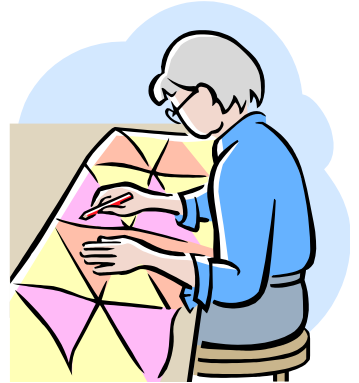
**Wrap all sewing notions inside the fabric and tie with string, yarn or a strip of fabric.**

## Quilts

Children, women of all ages and retired men in North America make them. Children, women and men of all ages in Africa, Asia, the Middle East and Latin America use them. The “them” are quilts, made with care and given with love to bring hope for a better life.

Quilts, highly prized by their recipients, are used for coverings on cold nights and as makeshift tents for protection from the sun during hot days. They become beds for those who have none and backpacks or totes to carry babies or possessions. In crowded refugee camps they provide some privacy when hung as room dividers. Quilts are used until they are literally in shreds.



Any new or good used fabric except fiberglass can be used to make quilts. Draperies, bedspreads, tablecloths, blankets and sheets offer the needed material. Even good discarded clothing can be ripped apart to make quilts.

The fabric needs to be cut only enough to fit it together easily. The different ways of piecing together harmonious colored fabric pieces of varied shapes and sizes make each quilt uniquely beautiful. Sturdy machine-sewn, neat and simple quilts are the best.

Quilts should be approximately 60 by 80 inches in size and about 3 to 4 pounds in weight. The number of layers will depend on the weight of the fabric. Use sheets, tablecloths, draperies, blankets (regular or electric with the wiring removed), mattress pads and even nylon stockings or panty hose (send for instructions) as fillers. Leftover pieces of embroidery floss or yarn, “or crochet thread or similar cord—easier to thread & pull through” can be used to tie the layers together.



You can donate good, clean used quilts and blankets just as they are.



## Health Kits

Clean hands, good grooming, bright and shining smiles - you can help bring them about through the gift of health kits.

### Each kit is to contain the following items:

- One hand towel
- One washcloth
- One bath size bar of any brand of soap *in it's original wrapping.*
- One comb, *wide toothed preferred.*
- One metal nail file, or nail clippers
- with file attached *in it's original wrapping*
- Six wrapped Band-Aids, preferably 1/2 to 3/4 inches. Wrap smaller items in wash clothes.
- One toothbrush in wrapper.



Wrap all the smaller items in the towel and tie securely with ribbons or yarn.

### Soap Standards

Lutheran World Relief is asking that soap donations include only **new bars** of any brand of soap, **in its original wrapping**. In the past, LWR has accepted new and used bars of soap, homemade soap, and soap slivers. Partner agencies overseas have more and more begun asking for only the new bars to facilitate easier and more uniform distribution. LWR is deeply grateful for the commitment of people who over the years have carefully collected, dried and made soap for people all over the world. Even though the soap standards have changed, we still need much help in reaching our overseas neighbors. We appreciate your continued efforts of the LWR parish projects as listed in the "Be Involved" brochure.

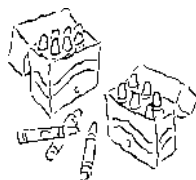

## School Kits

For children whose lives have been disrupted by war or some other disaster, receiving a school kit is a sign that someone far away cares. Adults in literacy classes appreciate the supplies needed to learn to read and write.

### **Each school kit is to contain the following items:**

- Pads or notebooks of ruled paper approximately 8 1/2 by 11 inches containing 150-200 sheets of paper.
- One blunt scissors. The “safety” scissors with imbedded steel blades is an excellent choice.
- One 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other.
- One pencil sharpener.
- Six new pencils with erasers.
- One eraser approximately 2 1/2 inches long.
- 12 sheets of construction paper in assorted colors.
- One box of 8, 16, or 24 crayons.
- One cloth bag 12 by 14 inches with cloth handles.



Pack all the items in the bag, fold the handles over and secure with two large rubber bands, if you wish.

Here is a “no waste” pattern for three cloth bags with handles made from a piece of sturdy fabric 30 by 45 inches. The seam allowance is 1/2 inch.
